# Marshall Rolls Over Yorktown

## Oct 15, 1971 OLIFF LEADS WAY FOR MARSHALL

Marshall evened its record at 3-3 as quarterback Mike Oliff scored two touchdowns on keeper plays to lead the Statesmen to a 20-0 victory over visiting Yorktown in a Virginia AAA non-district game.

The victory may have been a costly one for Marshall as running back Jay McKeever suffered a possible break of the collar bone. Prior to getting injured, McKeever rushed for 69 yards in 10 carries.

FAIRFAX — Marshall's hot Statesmen rolled over a non-protesting Yorktown team last night in local football action, 20-0.

Marshall's Al Boudreau lead all rushing with a 64-yard contribution to the Statesmen's stunning 289 yard total. Of that figure, the Marshall rushing game came out on top with a 184-yard factor, while air yardage came to 105. Marshall achieved 15 first downs; 10 through rushing, 4 through passing, and one from a penalty.

Charlie Payne intercepted for Marshall in the fourth quarter, but was taken down before he could advance.

Yorktown didn't fare as well in any department, as the Patriots were able to muster only a 78 yard total gain for the evening. The breakdown showed 37 yards of ground gain just barely following a 41-yard air game. Yorktown took five first downs; three through rushing and two passing.

Marshall's first quarter score resulted from a 58-yard drive, after which the ball went over to Yorktown. Yorktown failed to advance the ball to a favorable field position, and punted from about the 20. A few runs and two passes later, Marshall carried the ball over on a one-yard run by Mike Oliff. Paul Reedes tried to help with a kicked point, but failed.

The second quarter score was

arrived at in much the same way, with Yorktown punting, but not as well as before. Marshall took the ball on the Yorktown 40, and Mike Oliff took it over. A try at a conversion failed.

Earlier in the second quarter, though, Mike Little had

blocked a Yorktown punt and picked up a two-point safety, so the missed conversion didn't hurt as badly. The third quarter score was set up by an interception on the Statesmen 31 of a Patriot pass from the 50; a play finely executed by Mike Atalla. Mike Oliff again took

the ball over the goal line on a one-yard run, but the 5-yard pass to Steve Denning failed to achieve the conversion points.

One other interception was made by Marshall; this in the fourth quarter by Charlie Payne. However, Payne was hit before

he could move the ball appreciably.
