

# Marshall Thrashes McLean

Marshall thrashed McLean, 37-0, last night at Marshall and left Oakton at the top of the Virginia AAA Great Falls District with a 2-0 record. Marshall and McLean are 2-1 in the district.

Al Boudreau led Marshall's running assault with 155 yards and three touchdowns on 10 carries. Marshall gained 388 offensive yards to McLean's 89.

Linebacker Mike Little was a standout defensively, prowling through the McLean backfield and sacking the Highlander quarterback three times.
