

Second-Half Touchdowns Lead Upset for Cougars

OAKTON — Oakton's Cougars, destined to go no where in area scholastic football this season, registered what could go down as the upset of the year in the Great Falls District last night.

The Cougars, down 6-0 at intermission, scored touchdowns in the third and fourth quarters to defeat defending district and

Northern Region champion Marshall, 12-6.

John Chryst ran three yards for the Marshall touchdown in the first quarter and the Statesmen, who last week rolled over Falls Church, the team that conquered Annandale last night, made that margin hold up until midway in the third quarter.

Oakton moved the second half kickoff 70 yards in a drive capped by quarterback Tom Schwinel's one-yard plunge. The try for extra point failed and the score was tied.

Running back Jerry Lynott got the second touchdown on a 10-yard run. The kick for conversion failed but the Cougars had their victory, a most precious one.

Late Scores Lift Oakton Over Marshall

Oakton rallied in the second half to edge Marshall, 12-6, last night at Oakton in a Virginia AAA League Great Falls District game.

Marshall scored on its first drive, a march of 72 yards capped by John Chryst's three-yard scoring run. The Statesmen mounted a threat in the second period but fumbled at Oakton's one-yard line.

Oakton received the opening kickoff after halftime and, shortly after his 15-yard run, quarterback Tom Schrinel darted several feet for a score. Early in the fourth period, Oakton gained possession deep in Marshall territory to set up Jerry Lynott's three-yard scoring run.
