We judge ourselves by what we feel capable of doing, while others judge us by what we have already done.

Henry Wadsworth Longfellow

In making this observation, Longfellow put into words a truth which we all too often try to ignore.

How often have we read or heard of someone who has been highly successful in some way and said to ourselves, "I could do that, too, if I got the breaks." The vital difference, of course, is that we did not do it, whereas the other person did do it and people judged him for his accomplishments and recognized him accordingly.

How often do we rationalize our shortcomings in this manner when deep within us we know that, even to ourselves, the proof is in the deed. As our school year draws to a close, we have an opportunity to examine our accomplishments with Longfellow's words in mind. Are we satisfied with these accomplishments or are we merely trying to satisfy our conscience by saying, "I could have - - "?

They are the permanent, unchanging record of what we have done - not what we think we might have done. If that record is in keeping with our abilities, then the future is bright for us, for we have learned how to use our talents to our best advantage. If the record is anything less than a reflection of what we could do, then we should heed another saying of Longfellow's, "Something attempted, something done," for only by trying can we produce results.

### Science Club






The Science Club's two main objectives were (1) to give the students a chance to investigate areas not covered in class and (2) to promote and sponsor the Science Fair.

# Library Club






