In making this observation, Longfellow put into words a truth which we all too often try to ignore.



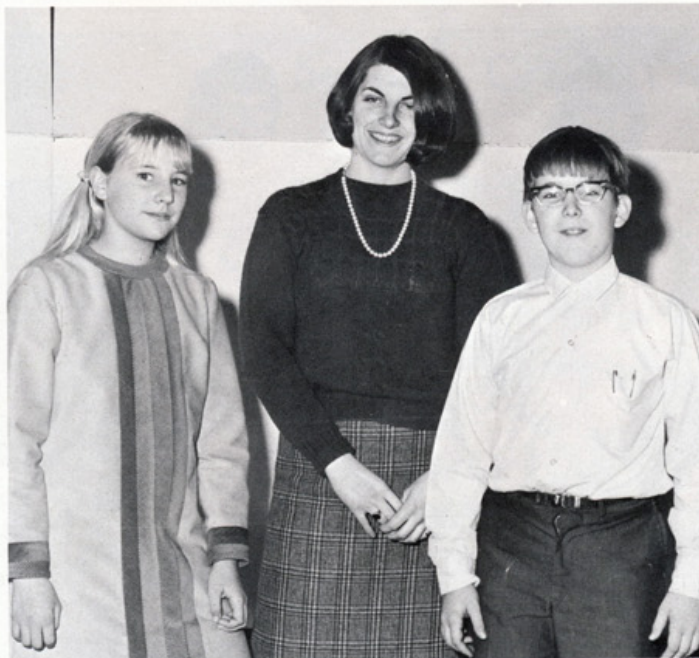
## Science Club
